



Junior High School Supplies for 2017-18

General Supplies

- **Sustainable water bottle** – we can't emphasize enough the importance of staying hydrated; water bottles are required of all students on campus and at the Land
- **Backpack** – A sturdy, supportive backpack (rolling backpack and carts are permitted)
- **Binder to aid students with organization** – one three-ring, zipper type binder your student will carry to each class; the binder should include:
 - Binder dividers with pockets (2 sets)
 - Loose leaf notebook paper
 - Zippered supply case that will insert into rings in binder
 - Pencil sharpener (hand held with top to catch shavings)
 - A minimum of 20 #2 Pencils
 - A minimum of 20 Blue or Black Pens
- **Note:** If your student has challenges staying organized, then he/she may need an individual organizational plan, and we can help develop it.
- **Note:** Greensboro Montessori School will provide highlighters, magic markers, Sharpies, scissors, glue sticks and gum erasers.

Math

- One spiral-bound notebook with graph paper (four squares per inch)
- All eighth and ninth graders will need a TI84 calculator (**Note:** available at McKay's, formerly Edward McKay's, and returning 9th levels may already have this item)

History

- One pack of colored pencils (preferably a Crayola 12 pack)
- Two packs of index cards
- One three- or five-subject, spiral-bound notebook
- One 1" three-ring binder
- A small box or package of page protectors to go in the binder

Science

- One Marble composition book
- One single-subject, spiral bound notebook with pockets (**Note:** may be a subsection of the larger binder listed above)

Language Arts

- Five purple pens for editing (**all written work must be completed in pen**)
- One single-subject composition book (college ruled, if available)
- One 1" three-ring binder
- Five dividers for binder

Spanish

- One single-subject, spiral-bound notebook (**Note:** students can also keep Spanish work in a section in the larger binder listed above)

Additional Items Needed

The following are expected to be a one-time purchase for the Junior High School years. Returning students may already have these items.

- Travel drive for computer (required at all times on campus)
- Earbuds or headphones (there will be instances where your child will need to listen to instructions or a video lesson)

PE Uniform

- Solid black shorts (**Note:** Shorts must meet dress code; the bottom hem must be no shorter than the ends of the fingers when standing with hands at sides.)
- Solid gray T-shirt
- Athletic footwear (rubber, non-marking tennis shoes)

Land Campus Supplies

- Sustainable water bottle (we can't emphasize enough the importance of staying hydrated; water bottles are required of all students on campus and at the Land)
- Whistle (imperative for health and safety reasons)
- Sleeping bag (lower limit rating of at least 20 degrees)
- Sleeping pad
- Hiking boots
- Close-toed shoes (no flip flops allowed)
- Rain gear
- Hat (protection from the sun)
