



## Upper Elementary School Supplies for 2017-18

- Pencil box or pouch
- Pencils (start with two boxes)
- Hand-held pencil sharpener
- Highlighter
- Two styli (to be used with iPads)
- Good eraser (e.g., Magic Rub)
- Colored pencils, preferably a Crayola 12 pack (these are primarily for language work, but also can be used for other subjects)
- Two packs of loose leaf paper, 150 sheets, wide ruled
- Flash drive (USB)
- 100 Index cards, lined
- Reusable water bottle (BPA free)
- Reusable lunch box or bag
- Wipeable placemat for use at snack and lunch (to be kept at school)
- Earbuds or headphones (not wireless) for use in the main classroom and in Spanish class
- Spanish Supplies **for Sixth-Grade Students only**
  - One 1½" three-ring binder with loose leaf paper or a spiral-bound notebook enclosed
  - One composition book

In addition to the items listed above, some students like to get and use large binders that zip to hold their planners, pencils, etc., or like to have separate binders for various subjects. During the day, students have a cubby where they keep their notebooks, books and binders. Some students also use small shelves, bookends or organizers for their cubbies.
